RENOVA Announces Joining World Forum Offshore Wind Masahiro Yoshida (Co-Head, Engineering Division) Speaks at Online Seminar

RENOVA, Inc. (Chuo-ku, Tokyo; Founding CEO Yosuke Kiminami; hereinafter "RENOVA") is pleased to announce that it has joined <u>World Forum Offshore Wind</u> (hereinafter "WFO"), a non-profit organization working with the aim of promoting offshore wind energy on a global scale. On October 13, RENOVA's <u>Masahiro Yoshida</u> (Co-Head, Engineering Division) will speak at a webinar held by WFO entitled "Offshore Wind Development Challenges," introducing RENOVA's offshore wind energy business development efforts.

WFO is a non-profit organization that communicates information, encourages collaborations between companies in various countries and fosters understanding among government officials with a view to promoting the widespread global adoption of offshore wind energy. Since its establishment in Germany in 2018, WFO has been joined by over 60 global companies and non-profit organizations, encompassing the complete offshore wind value chain including utility companies, manufacturers, financial, legal and insurance service firms. In 2020, WFO established the Floating Offshore Wind Committee with the aim of accelerating the international spread of floating offshore wind energy projects, which are the focus of great expectations for the future, and member companies are engaging in vigorous activities.

RENOVA has begun empirical research envisaging specific sea areas in cooperation with several partners both in Japan and overseas, with the aim of actualizing floating offshore wind power generation. Through its participation in WFO and the Floating Offshore Wind Committee, RENOVA will cooperate with participating companies and organizations to solve issues relating to matters such as policy, costs, safety standards and consensus building, and contribute to the actualization of a decarbonized society through the expansion of floating offshore wind power generation.

WFO also holds monthly webinars on themes such as offshore wind market trends in each country and the latest offshore wind technologies. By actively participating in these activities, RENOVA will advance collaborations with member companies and organizations both in Japan and overseas. RENOVA's Masahiro Yoshida will speak in a webinar on October 13, on the theme of "Offshore Wind Development Challenges," introducing RENOVA's offshore wind business development efforts and the company's awareness of issues gained through its development experiences.
